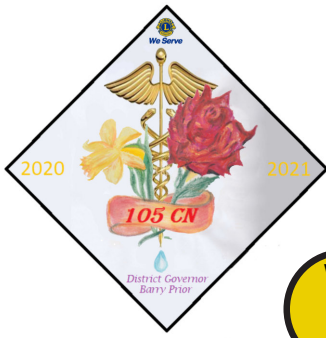

The evening will start with a touch of charter formality, and be followed by a Murder Mystery - Murder at the Manor.

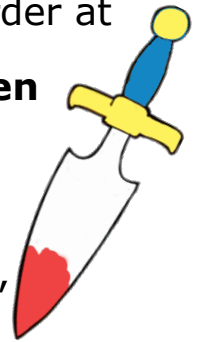
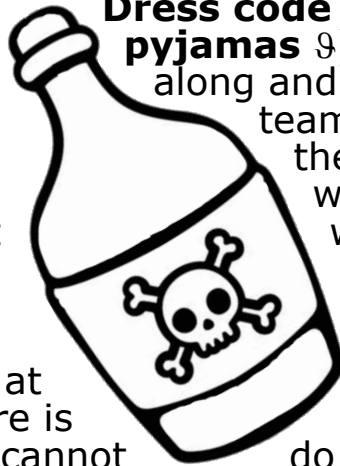
