DISTRICT BANK ACCOUNTS

Admin Account. Please make cheques payable to '**LCI District 105CN Admin**'. Write on the reverse of the cheque what the payment is intended for. Send to PDG Tony Clarkson, 24 Fairfield Street, Accrington, BB5 0LD. Bank Transfer to- HSBC, Sort Code 40 - 37 - 20 - Account No: 31364685. Please email Tony to advise that you have made a bank transfer payment, advising him of the intended fund allocation.

Charity Account. Please make cheques payable to '**LCI District 105CN Charity**'. Write on the reverse how the donations should be allocated. Send to: PDG Frank Marnell, 97 York Road, Connahs Quay, Flintshire, CH5 4YF. Bank Transfer to - HSBC, Sort Code 40 - 31 - 02 - Account No 71376837. Please email Frank to advise that you have made a bank transfer payment, advising him of how you wish the donation to be allocated.

BEAT THE LOCK-DOWN BLUES AND INCREASE YOUR IT SKILLS

Continuing, from last week's item, on completing forms in PDFs, there is another powerful tool, in the free Adobe DC PDF Reader, is the Search facility.

From within a PDF, you can initiate a search by selecting **Edit**, from the top menu and then selecting **Find** from the drop down menu (**Keyboard Shortcut: CTRL and F**). This action will open a search window, at the top RHS of the page, Click in the white search line and type in the word/ name that you wish to find. At the RHS of the search line, there is a cog symbol. Clicking on this allows you to set search criteria, such as case and whole words.

But, what if you have a folder full of PDFs, such as Newsletters or Directories for each of the MD105 Districts and, you are not sure which file contains the information, that you require! The Adobe DC PDF Reader also has an advanced search facility, to deal with that.

Open the folder, that contains the PDFs, that you wish to search and, open one of the PDFs, in that folder. Select **Edit**, from the top menu and then select **Advanced Search**, from the drop down menu (**Keyboard Shortcut: CTRL, SHIFT and F**).

You will now be presented with a search window, Select 'All PDF Documents in' and click the down arrow on the bar, below and select **Browse for Location**.

At this point, you can drill down the directory tree to find your folder, or, if you know the folder path, you can type it into the 'Folder' bar.

One shortcut is to click in the top bar of the folder, so that the folder path is highlighted in blue, Right click it and select **copy**. Back in the 'Browse for Location' box, sweep the cursor, from right to left, to highlight any characters already in there. Right click the highlighted characters and select **Paste**. The original text will be replaced by your folder path. Click OK and then enter the word or phrase that you would like to search for and then, click the search button. You will get a warning message about the operation requiring read access to your drive. Press **Allow** to continue.



















The search will commence, producing a list instances, where the word or phrase occurs. Clicking the arrow to the left of each result will give a preview of the line or phrase. Clicking on the title/filename will open the document.

NOTE: The name shown, in the search results, for the document, may not be its filename. It may default to the document title, allocated by the application that produced the PDF.
